



Global First Nations Carbon Summit Accelerates International Stakeholders

Regina, Saskatchewan – October 13, 2022 – **Carbon RX Inc. (“Carbon RX”)** initiated a new ecosystem of carbon market influencers at the inaugural Global First Nations Carbon Summit which was held in Regina, Saskatchewan on October 3, 2022. First Nations Chiefs and Councils, government, technology companies, testing agencies and purchasers of carbon offsets, gathered to discuss the emerging opportunities in the carbon economy.

“This summit was born from the need to discuss the importance of the carbon markets and establish a gateway for First Nations leaders to take their seat at the economic table and exercise their environmental sovereignty. We knew the sector was emerging and hot, but we never anticipated interest like this,” says Marty Seymour, Chief Operating Officer, Carbon RX.

Content at the event ranged from global mining giant BHP’s net zero strategy to the emerging space of indigenous carbon capture projects, to the importance and related demand of nature-based carbon offsets. The presence of the Honourable Bob Rae, Canada’s Ambassador to the UN, accentuated the global interest in the summit and importance of climate change mitigation strategies.

“Nature-based carbon offsets are popular right now. C-suite leaders who buy carbon offsets want projects in their communities that help the environment. Forestry and agriculture are emerging as a class of carbon offsets the market is enthusiastic about buying,” notes Seymour, “Indigenous originated carbon offsets are even better.”

Of significant interest at the conference was the environmental sovereignty panel anchored by Chief Heidi Cook, Misipawistik First Nation and Sheldon Wuttunee, the Saskatchewan First Nations Natural Resource Centre of Excellence.
